What cookies are

As is common on most professional websites, this site uses cookies, which are small files downloaded to your computer, to improve your experience. It is therefore recommended that you do not disable cookies.

The cookies we set

- Cookies associated with your account

If you create an account with us, we will use cookies to manage the registration process and general administration. These cookies are usually deleted when you log out, but in some cases they may remain after you log out to remember your site preferences when you log out.

- Cookies related to electronic newsletters

This site offers newsletter or e-subscription services and cookies may be used to remember whether you are already registered and to show certain notifications that may be relevant only to registered/unregistered users.

Cookies from third-party vendors

In some special cases, we also use cookies provided by trusted third-party vendors. The following section details the third-party cookies you may encounter when using this site.

- This website uses Google Analytics, which is one of the most widely used and trusted analytics tools on the internet to help us understand how you use the site and where we can improve your experience. These cookies can track things like how long you stay on the site and the pages you visit so that we can continue to create engaging content.
